



COVID-19: Screening Checklist for Visitors and Employees

On March 13, 2020, CMS and CDC updated guidance on restricting all SNF visitors and non-essential healthcare personnel, except for certain compassionate care situations, such as end-of-life.

ALL individuals (employees, family, visitors, government officials) entering the building must be asked the following questions:

1.	Has this individual washed their hands or used alcohol-based hand rub (ABHR) on entry? ☐ YES ☐ NO − please ask them to do so
2.	Ask the individual if they have any of the following respiratory symptoms? □ Fever □ Sore throat □ Cough □ New shortness of breath
	If YES to any, restrict them from entering the building. If NO to all, proceed to question #3 for employees and step #4 for all others.
3A.	For employees, check temperature and document results (not required for visitors) □ Fever present?
	If YES, restrict from entering the building. If NO, proceed to step 3B.
3B.	For employees, ask if they have: ☐ Worked in facilities with recognized COVID-19 cases?
	If YES, ask if they worked with person with confirmed COVID-19?
	□ YES □ NO
	If YES, restrict them from entering the building. If NO, proceed to step 4.
4.	Allow entry to building and remind the individual to: ☐ Wash their hands or use ABHR throughout their time in the building. ☐ Not shake hands with, touch or hug individuals during their visit. ☐ Visitors that are permitted for compassionate care situations must wear a facemask while in the building and restrict their visit to the resident's room or other location designated by the facility.
